

With the increasing popularity of the Buffalo Creek Area, it is important that all trail users understand and practice proper trail etiquette. When you encounter other trail users, make verbal contact by saying 'hello' or 'good morning' to get their attention. Once contact has been made, yield the right-of-way in all circumstances with Hikers secondary. Mountain Bikers need to take special care when approaching other users and should slow to a walking speed when passing and yield to all other trail users. Also, trail users traveling uphill have the right-of-way over downhill traffic. Courtesy is important and contagious!
